Employment Opportunities

The Police Athletic League of Philadelphia offers many paid positions during the academic year to work with the youth in our centers.

Programs run Monday-Thursday. No programs are offered on the weekends. If applicant is under 18 years of age, applicant must obtain working papers.

Not all positions are available at every PAL center

- **Homework Club Tutor:** Provide support to the PAL officer in supervising the Homework Club. Help youth with their homework and maintain a positive environment for studying. Tutor youth in need of extra support. Position is for 8 hrs/week and runs for 32 weeks. Position pays \$10/hour.
- **Computer Club Instructor:** Provide support to the PAL officer in overseeing the Computer Lab. Assist youth with using the computers. Lead youth through Comcast Computer Education Program to help them develop the necessary computer skills to be successful. Must be fluent in Microsoft Office. Position is 4 hrs/week and runs for two separate 12-week sessions (September-December and March-May). Position pays \$10/hour.
- **Positive Images Mentor:** Provide support to the PAL officer in running mentor program for young girls and coordinate speakers for the girls in the program. Position is 2hrs/week and runs for two separate 12-week sessions (September-December and March-May). Position pays \$10/hour.
- **Snack Program Assistant:** Assists the PAL officer with the distribution and documentation of afternoon snacks to the youth in the center. Applicant must be ages 14-17 and obtain working papers. Position is 8hrs/week and runs for 28 weeks. Position pays \$7.15/hour.
